WORKSHOP CONTENT

The workshop will deal with the value of culture and the role of cultural journalism in the context of social and political challenge as well as practical features of writing interviews and critical texts on the performing arts.

Workshop participants will

- form an editorial office for the duration of the festival
- attend performances, discuss them and write about them
- experiment with different text genres such as report, review, essay, interview etc. and search for new approaches
- exchange experience and new knowledge in the field of cultural journalism
- have the opportunity to establish partnerships with their colleagues
- publish their own texts on a multilingual blog (texts can be published in any language and will be translated to English and/or German)

Participants will be selected on the basis of the following criteria

- experience in journalism and interest in covering cultural activities
- quality of previous news stories and/or critical articles
- willingness to share the acquired knowledge in their countries
- proficiency in English
- guaranteed participation for the whole duration of the project
- participants are expected to publish at least one article about their experience in a newspaper in their home country

Ten participants will be selected based on the above criteria. The selection results will be announced on 20th December 2017. The organiser will cover travel costs, visa related costs as well as accommodation and per diems for successful candidates.
