



Study visits <u>for drama schools, art schools and</u> <u>humanities departments</u> at the Grotowski Institute, Wrocław, Poland

Within this programme, the Grotowski Institute offers 5-to-10-day-long stays for students and their teachers at its venues in Wrocław. Students will be given opportunities to hone their acting skills in practice in addition to attending lectures and screenings of films from the Institute's archives. The aim of the study visits is to enable students to establish links, exchange experiences and methods of work, build their acting skills and knowledge as well as creating a space for dialogue and understanding to get together to ask questions and search for answers in practice. The programme builds on many years of experience gained working with Polish and international drama schools and institutes, including Rose Bruford College (Londyn), the Royal Academy of Dramatic Arts (RADA, London), Rasaboxes (New York), the Royal School for Dramatic Arts (RESAD, Madrid), Escuela Superior de Arte Dramático (Murcia), the Boris Shchukin Theatre Institute (Moscow) and the National Academy of Theatre Arts in Kraków and its Branch in Wrocław.

As part of the programme, the Institute offers:

 a paid programme of actor training and lectures, developed in consultation with the drama schools.

Spanning five to ten days, these study visits are addressed towards students of drama schools, art schools and humanities departments such as theatre studies and cultural studies, and their supervisors. Each day will include a five-hour practical workshop and a three-hour conservatory including lectures and film screenings.

Groups are expected to cover the costs of travel, including local transportation, as well as the cost of their accommodation, food and insurance in Wrocław, and to complete all the requirements and paperwork related to their arrival.
