





The new directors announced the new programme direction in a joint video statement: Theater der Welt 2023 is curated by Chiaki Soma and Kyoko Iwaki of Arts Commons Tokyo.

Theater der Welt, a festival of the ITI has been awarded to a different German city every three years since 1981 and is financed in equal parts by the host city, the federal state and the federal government. For the 2023 edition, the ITI organised a call for tenders for the first time, in which Frankfurt's application was successful together with Offenbach. The programme direction was also put out to international tender for the first time.

Call for Papers: 8th International Seminar of Ritual & Traditional Theatre Performances 2021

The Executive Committee of the 8th International Seminar along with holding the 20th Festival of Ritual & Traditional Performances is going to organize some science-research seminars in the following two sections in some areas around classic approaches, contemporary theories of methodology, universal scientific conformity and future vision through inviting Iranian and foreign researchers of ritual and traditional theatre performances.

The Priorities of the First Section deals with 1) The principles and rules of ritual &

cultural of Iran; 4) Interdisciplinary relations of ritual & traditional theatre performances with other arts; 5) Introducing the ritual & traditional theatre performances with their performing styles among Iranian ethnic nations; 6) The ancient, gnostic and philosophical roots of ritual & traditional theatre performances; 7) The presentation of articles extracted from the university students' theses related to ritual & traditional theatre performances.

The Priorities of the Second Section (Future Vision of Tradition) is concerned with 1) Future research with the focus on ritual & traditional theatre performances, the areas of change and natural life, nostalgic functions, ethereal proportions, techno pathology, revoke and return concepts, etc.; 2) Research methods and new perspectives in ritual & traditional theatre performances, aesthetics, semiology, visualization, metaphysical post; 3) Subjective and objective functions of ritual & traditional theatre performance in contemporary and avant-garde theatre; 4) The role of linguistic changes in the revolution of ritual & traditional theatre performances based on modern theories; 5) Joint or contrast of metaphysic and non-metaphysic theories in interpreting the ritual & traditional theatre performances.

Those interested in participating in the seminar can submit their papers until **6 September 2021** to the emails below. The jury will announce the accepted papers by 16 September. The accepted articles will be presented in the 8th International Seminar of Ritual & Traditional Theatre Performances and researcher will receive the Certificate of Participation.

The 8th **International Seminar of Ritual & Traditional Theatre** Performances will be held in two formats of a) in-person and b) virtual to present the articles (lecturing and poster) and hold workshops and meeting in the second half of October. The presented articles will be published in the book of the seminar.
