**Cabaret "Let it stay among us" Skopje, (Sara Spirkoska – actress as special guest)**

After successful performances in Belgrade, Banja Luka and Kotor, the regional tour of the cabaret "Let it stay among us " continues with a guest tour in Skopje. The event is organized by the Macedonian Center ITI/PRODUCTION in cooperation with KIC Skopje – Salon 1919, on February 22, 2025, starting at 8 p.m. A special guest will be the Macedonian actress Sara Spirkoska. What happens when a Macedonian girl sings a duet with the Banja Luka self-proclaimed poet Nebojša Kuruzović, it is certain that it will resonate and be seen; To remain "among us" for many years to come.

#### **ABOUT THE CABARET**

It's likely that you've ever had an honest conversation with a person, after which it becomes clear that you've become more connected and intimate. On the other hand, you are somewhat sorry that this conversation has not been documented to remain for generations to come. It is this moment that will take place on stage through the socially engaged cabaret drama that is performed through the heartfelt lyrics of Nebojša Kuruzović and turns the music into a duo drama in the moment of performance, between the performers and some of the guests in the audience. The artist allows the person in the audience to freely come forward and have an honest conversation with him/her on the topics hidden in the hats such as: "Crisis of democracy", "Reconciliation and challenges of the digital world" and "Love and solidarity will save the world". Depending on the theme they choose, at the end of the conversation, they will be able to pull out the name of the song that will be performed and accompanied by the best jazz band from Banja Luka – "Kombine". Special guest from Macedonia will be actress Sarah Spirkoska; who will perform a unique poetic duet with Nebojša Kuruzović. You'll find out what it looks like if you join us. Just—'Let it stay among us.'

The regional tour is implemented under the project "The Art of Public Speaking and Regional Cooperation" with the support of the British Council, and under the Culture and Creativity for the Western Balkans grant framework CC4WBs.
